Brooke Jamison is the Associate Administrator of the Foreign Agricultural Service, overseeing the USDA Foreign Service and Global Programming. She is a native of Aurora, CO. She received a Bachelor's degree in International Relations from Tufts University in 1998, and a Master's of Science in Control of Infectious Diseases from the London School of Hygiene and Tropical Medicine in 2004.
