Chase Sova is senior director of Public Policy and Research at World Food Program USA (WFP USA), Senior Associate (non-resident) with the Center for Strategic and International Studies Global Food and Water Security Program and a Term Member of the Council on Foreign Relations. Previously, Chase worked with the United Nations Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO), International Center for Tropical Agriculture (CIAT) and the CGIAR Research Program on Climate Change, Agriculture and Food Security (CCAFS). He has consulted with the World Bank, Johns Hopkins, and Tufts University. Interested in the intersection of food insecurity and conflict, humanitarian assistance, climate change,

and sustainable agriculture, Chase has worked on food systems in 15 developing countries across Latin America, sub-Saharan Africa and South Asia. He has led several major research initiatives including WFP USA's *Dangerously Hungry: The Link Between Food Insecurity and Conflict* flagship report. Chase has served as an expert witness at the Senate Foreign Relations Committee, his writing has been featured extensively in peer-reviewed journals, and he regularly lectures on food insecurity at Universities in Washington, D.C. He delivered a TEDx talk on "Winning the Long Game in the Fight to End Hunger" in 2018. Chase earned his Ph.D. from Oxford University.
